Main themes	To meet these objectives, the course is twofold: Module A - Heuristics (1 ECTS - 20 h common activities) - initiation to bibliographical research in theology, to the optimal use of UCL libraries, especially the Bibliothèque de théologie (BTEC) and the general services of the Bibliothèque des arts et des lettres (BFLT) to Internet and e-mail. Module B - Written work (10 ECTS) - preparation of a written paper (20 - 30 pages) on a topic in the fields of theology or religious sciences.
