Main themes	The masters dissertation, irrespective of the subject, allows a student to : - summarise a given scientific topic, - put a specific issue in context drawing on existing information, - present the results of the dissertation.
Aims	<p>1 The dissertation must demonstrate the student's ability to describe correctly the results of a personal, objective and methodical work. The length of the dissertation is not a criteria in evaluating its quality. Similar to the other forms of learning, the dissertation is an essential component of the programme to which it belongs. Content	The Individual Final Project must be at least 50 pages. It should include: introduction; development; Conclusion and bibliography. It is a piece of writing in the style of a dissertation but presented more as a speech.
