Evaluation methods	<p>Translation exam in the working conditions of a professional translator's workstation. The overall evaluation may also cover specific parts of the student's work accomplished during the workshop (for more details, please refer to the terms and specifications of each of the three workshops).</p> <p>Each specialized translation workshop is worth one third of the final evaluation of the training unit.</p> <p>Only the components failed during the first session will be the subject of the second session. If the EU is not validated at the end of a year, all the fields (legal, economic, scientific and technical) must be presented the following year.</p>
Teaching methods	<p>In-situ training in specialized translation in the working conditions of a professional translator's workstation ; preliminary work via the e-learning platform (if need be).</p> <p>The student's presence is requested at all in-situ training sessions of the translation workshops.</p>
Content	<p>Specialized translation : Law matters : introduction consisting of a contrastive study of legal fields and contract law in Russian and French, Russian-French translation of the contracts most commonly used in the translator's practice (contracts of sale, lease, insurance, etc.)</p> <p>Specialized translation ' Economic matters : Russian-French translation of texts of a general nature treating economic matters, commercial correspondence.</p> <p>Specialized translation : Technical and scientific matters : contrastive study of the specialized technical and scientific language in Russian and French, Russian-French translation of technical or scientific popularization texts.</p>
