Main themes	This course explores, from a number of angles, the political ideas which have shaped the history of Europe. Particular attention will be paid to the emergence and development of values fundamental to European political culture, such as democracy, individual freedom, equality and solidarity. We will relate these discussions to current events.
Aims	<p>Students will gain a firm grasp of certain political concepts, such as freedom, democracy and equality.
