Compulsory Placement Test: at the beginning of the academic year, all students must take this ONLINE test (on Moodle). This test is the same level as the exam. On the basis of the results, students have access to the intensive or « normal » course/ coaching sessions.  2. First-Term Test (10%): at the end of the first term, students MUST take a test assessing the vocabulary (videos/texts/Wallangues), grammar and reading/listening skills covered in class. Students cannot be exempted from the course material. The test will take place on Moodle Exams.  3. The Final (Written) Exam: The final exam takes place in May (cfr Moodle).
