Main themes	The seminar will deal with a topic in the area of practical philosophy to be determined by its members, in relation to research projects they are working on. Attendance at meetings of the seminar and active participation in discussions is strongly encouraged. Professors and other researchers from the UCLouvain interested in the topic, as well as other specialists on the topic from outside the UCLouvain, may participate in the seminar.
