Aims	1 Provide a foundation course in Dutch phonetics, phonology and morphology. Evaluation methods	<b>Due to the COVID-19 crisis, the information in this section is particularly likely to change.</b> Oral examination To pass this course, it is necessary to pass both parts of the exam (phonology and morphology). A failure of one of the two parts implies a failure for the entire course. On the other hand, if you pass one of the two parts of the exam, you will be exempted for that part at the next examination session. At the oral exam special attention will be paid to the language skills (in particular the pronunciation of Dutch).
Teaching methods	<b>Due to the COVID-19 crisis, the information in this section is particularly likely to change.</b> Mixed approach of lectures, reading of scientific articles and exercises.
Content	The course is an introduction to Dutch phonetics, phonology and morphology. Phonetics and phonology (vowels, diphthongs, consonants; co-articulation; accentuation and intonation). Morphology (especially lexical morphology, loanwords and neologisms).
