Each exam comprises a variety of question types, exclusively focused on practical exercises designed to verify the student's understanding of the theory.</li> <li>• Summative assessment counts for 100% of the course unit's final mark. The first academic term exam counts for 30 %, and the second academic term exam counts for 70 % of the final mark.</li> </ul>
