Evaluation methods	<p>A quarter of the points will be devoted to your participation in the course. $\frac{3}{4}$ of the points will be devoted to the presentation of an eight- to ten-page paper. Content	<p>Unlike other <i>ex cathedra</i> courses, this course on EU sectoral environmental and health policies is deemed to be much more interactive because of the seriousness of the ecological crisis. The aim is to provide you with food for thought about the reforms underway as part of the European Green Deal. In my capacity as a university Professor (<i>professor ordinarius</i>), I closely follow the implementation of the Green Deal.
