Egypt's relations with the Hittites in the 19th Dynasty (notably the Qadesh battle of Ramesses II);</li> <li>3. relations between Egypt and Nubia, from the beginnings to the Meroitic kingdom;</li> <li>4. expeditions to Punt and Sinai, from the Old Kingdom.</li> </ol>
