Teaching methods	The student will work in a private archives service and will benefit from the supervision of his or her internship supervisor (an archivist by training and by profession).
Content	<p>According to the possibilities of the integrated service, the student will carry out or participate in the realization of potentially diverse tasks :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • evaluation, collection, acquisition of an archive fonds • visit to a production department (for example, as part of training or an inspection audit) • intellectual (and possibly material) treatment of a fonds • participation in missions to enhance the value of the patrimony • participation in welcoming and advising visitors
