Prerequisites	This teaching unit being of intermediate level, the productive command of basic grammar and vocabulary as well as the command of the language skills at <b>B1</b> level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages
Main themes	This teaching unit focuses on interactive communication as it takes place in everyday practice in the dental office.
Learning outcomes	<p><b>At the end of this learning unit, the student is able to :</b></p> <p><b>Speaking Skills (main objective) - Interactive</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• take an active part in discussion in familiar contexts, accounting for and sustaining his/her views.</li> <li>• interact with a certain degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with native speakers quite possible provided the latter adapt their language level.</li> </ul> <p><b>1 Speaking Skills (main objective) - Individual</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• give (after preparation) a simple and clearly developed presentation on a field-related subject and to manage the following debate.</li> <li>• explain a viewpoint on a topical issue well enough in order to be understood without difficulty.</li> </ul> <p><i>Level B2- of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages</i></p> <p><b>Listening Comprehension - Interactive</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• understand most conversations and debates bearing on field-related subjects.</li> <li>• understand most of what is said in an everyday conversation provided standard language is being used.</li> </ul> <p><b>2 Listening Comprehension - Individual</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• understand extended speech and lectures and follow even complex lines of argument provided the topic is reasonably familiar (field-related),</li> <li>• understand most TV news and current affairs programs provided the topic is reasonably familiar (field-related).</li> </ul> <p><i>Level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages</i></p> <p><b>Reading Comprehension</b></p> <p><b>3</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• read articles and reports concerned with contemporary and field related problems in which the writers adopt particular attitudes or viewpoints.</li> <li>• understand standard field-related correspondence.</li> </ul> <p><b>Code</b></p> <p><b>4</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Vocabulary : consolidation of basic vocabulary (+/- 2000 words) and assimilation of specific vocabulary (+/- 500 words).</li> <li>• Grammar: consolidation of the command of specific structures of the Dutch language.</li> </ul> <p>The use of vocabulary and grammar is seen from a communicative viewpoint. Nevertheless, accuracy is not neglected.</p>
Evaluation methods	<p>1. Continuous assessment (participation in class, presentation of a field- related subject). This assessment counts for 33% in the final assessment.</p> <p>2. Oral and written exam. 33% of the final note each</p>

Teaching methods	<p>This teaching unit focuses on interactive communication. The proposed written and oral activities therefore aim at developing communication skills in that area, as well as improving the command of the language.</p> <p>These activities are of two types:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. presentation and training of language functions (everyday socializing, telephoning, contributing to a meeting, a debate or a negotiation, writing a summary, an e-mail,),</li> <li>2. individual and interactive speaking activities related to the field of study. This part includes a presentation on a topic related to the field of study.</li> </ol>
Content	<p>This teaching unit aims at developing the written and oral communication skills of the student in his/her field of study: dental medicine.</p> <p>More precisely it involves</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• the training of interactive communication,</li> <li>• the presentation and training of communication skills (everyday socializing, telephoning, contributing to a meeting, a debate or a negotiation, writing a report, a summary, an e-mail, presentation on a topic related to the field of study),</li> <li>• the improvement of the command of general and specific vocabulary and grammar in order to put these communication skills into practice.</li> </ul>
