Content	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Q 1: Oral expression work and oral comprehension exercises based on the basic disciplinary vocabulary studied in MLE (Level A1-A2). <p>(sich vorstellen, Aussehen und Charakter, Umwelt, Welt der Gefühle...)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Q 2: Oral expression work and oral comprehension exercises in the language laboratory based on the disciplinary vocabulary studied in MLE (Level B1). <p>(die Suche nach Glück, Probleme der Jugend, der Zustand unseres Planeten...). Phonetics exercises are used to strengthen students' oral expression and comprehension skills.</p>
