Evaluation methods	<p>The assessment consists of two parts</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- a personal written assignment due on the first day of the session;</li> <li>- a written application exam.</li> </ul> <p>The assessment procedures (conditions for success, etc.) and the instructions for the written assignment are explained at the beginning of the course.</p> <p>The assignment is worth 50% of the final mark.                      The written exam is worth 50% of the final mark.                      The use of artificial intelligence tools is prohibited.</p>
Teaching methods	The course alternates between lectures and exercises. Students are regularly asked to work on various documents during class sessions.
Content	<p>The course consists of two parts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Training in bibliographical research: presentation of research tools in Romance studies, documentary research, bibliographical referencing, critical approach to bibliographical resources, definition of plagiarism, etc.</li> <li>- Analysis and practice of university-level texts: learning how to write scientific summaries, introductions and conclusions, etc.</li> </ul>
