Evaluation methods	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Continuous assessment in each term (plan and instructions in coursnotes) (regular classattendance is required to obtain a mark for the continuous assessment)= 20 %</li> <li>• Written test at the end of each term : code 20%, listening comprehension (t1) and writing (t2) 20%, vocabulary 20%= 60 %</li> <li>• Oral exam (discussion about classtopic, videos, pronunciation and student's portfolio) at the end of each term = 20 %</li> <li>• For the examen in september, there is no mark for the continuous assessment. Written examen (vocabulary 20%, grammar 20%, writing and listening 20% and oral examen (same topics as in term 25% and presentation 15%).</li> </ul> <p>These exam and teaching modalities could be transposed to online teaching and learning according to the evolution of the health situation.</p>
Teaching methods	<p>The more general vocabulary and the field-related vocabulary will be presented in written as well as audio texts used to exercise the reading and listening comprehension techniques.</p> <p>The vocabulary and the typical structures will be revised, extended and tested.</p> <p>Some techniques of communication will be exercised by means of written and oral production exercises (role plays, presentations).</p>
Content	<p>This Teaching Unit aims at developing the student's receptive skills by the input of written and spoken texts ; at developing the student's ability to express his point of view and speak about a chosen subject in public ; at</p>

	developing the student's writing skills by the redaction of formal letters and summaries of films ; at broadening the student's knowledge and view of the german-speaking culture.
