Teaching methods	The course is based on different themes. Learning is contextualised by didactic and/or authentic documents (reading and listening comprehension). Vocabulary and basic structures are trained, consolidated and extended through written and oral exercises (drills, roleplays, interviews, conversations in small groups, debates,). In speaking skills, the focus is on communication rather than on correction, however phonetical correction will be stressed. An interactive and cultural approach is favoured.
