Main themes	<p>From the description and analysis of their practices, the master thesis project of each student will aim to improve practices by carrying out an applied research in their professional environment. Theoretical analysis frameworks and tools will be proposed and worked on, so that everyone can use them for this capstone final production.</p> <p>In line with the Scholarship of Teaching and Learning approach, the output of the dissertation will be twofold:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • a written output, which may take the form of a research article, for example, and • an oral presentation, aimed at disseminating the results of the work to other teachers in higher education, either within the institution or as part of events for the dissemination of research or practice.
