| Main themes | <p>To achieve its objectives, the course consists of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - presenting a historical and doctrinal synthesis of the question of the one God and Triune; - introducing to the current problems, situating them in the contemporary context; - initiating the practice of dogmatic theology. <p>This part of the course includes an introduction to the elaboration of a problem and a practical introduction to the bibliographic instruments; it leads the student to write a work which gives him/her the opportunity to put into practice the elements of this initiation and to develop an active relation with the material.</p> |
| Learning outcomes | <p>At the end of this learning unit, the student is able to :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 - describe the stages of the development of the Trinitarian dogma ; 2 - name the theological problems connected with the confession of the one God and Triune ; 3 - indicate the terms in which the question of God is posed to the contemporary mentality ; 4 - deal with a particular issue with the help of appropriate bibliographic instruments. |
