Content	The seminar studies territorial politics from three main perspectives: first, how the <i>polity</i> of Western European nation-states has been affected by processes of regionalization; second, how <i>policymaking and policy implementation</i> are altered by regionalization; and, third, how <i>politics</i> within regionalized states reflects multilevel dynamics.
