Content	<p>This course is composed of three parts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The presentation of the evaluation rules of financial law, i.e. the ways of codifying economic realities in accounting data; - A development of the methods of analysing the most common financial statements: restructuring in economic and financial masses, ratios, flow statements; - An initiation to consolidation accounting, i.e. accounting of corporate groups.
