He will be able to distinguish logic and to differentiate it from it from the functional movement. It will be able to improvise personal versions and to compose of the studies of danced movement.</p>
Evaluation methods	<p>The aim of the assessment is to measure the achievement of the targeted learning outcomes.</p> <p>An external expert may be invited during the assessment and may give an opinion.</p> <p>Attendance is required. Content	The objectives will be met through two complementary content practices - Dance gear with openness to different musical styles gestural creation + dance - Extension of training in body floor (see EDPH1003) and choreography in a scene inspired by the sports movement.
