The history and development of English: origin of the language, evolution, diversification 2. The sounds of English: consonants, vowels, diphthongs, allophones; word stress; intonation 3. The structure and meaning of English words: morphemes, morphs, allomorphs; inflection and derivation; word formation processes; neologisms 4. The discourse of English: descriptive and critical discourse analysis; ecolinguistics <p>The course unit also shows how the tools of corpus linguistics make it possible to approach these different elements.</p> |
