Place of the course	Louvain-la-Neuve			
Main themes	The 50-hour training period is divided in three parts: 1. Classroom observation and analysis of pedagogical practices (10h): the aim is to push the student to project himself being in charge of the class by meeting his future pupils and training supervisor. 2. Teaching practice (40h): the aim is to allow the future teacher to experience the different points approached in the theoretical courses under the guidance of training supervisors registered by the UCLouvain. 3. Presentation of report lessons.			
Learning outcomes	At the end of this learning unit, the student is able to: 1. design, plan and teach philosophy classes in upper secondary education, 2. think about his teaching practice and regulate it, 3. adapt to different professional situations in different school environments by interacting with training supervisors.			
Content	The training periods consist of 40h of teaching and 10h of classroom observation. During each training period, the student will be taken care of by a training supervisor chosen by the head of training. The student chooses his training supervisors in the list of training supervisors registered by the UCLouvain. He agrees with them on the modalities of the classroom observation and the active lessons.
