Teaching methods	Teaching in presential mode by practice and examples. Learning how to manage and subtitle video footage with various types of general content, difficulty levels, lengths, and linguistic quality. Qualitative feedback by the teacher who will correct and comment on each subtitling exercise.				
Content	Subtitling of general video footage, introduction on the topic, explanations and comments, documentary, script transcript, documentary and terminological research, management of subtitling carried out in group, subtitling, terminological consistency and proofreading of the final product. Production of a subtitled video footage the quality of which shows a satisfactory level relative to the acquired theoretical knowledge and practical skills.
