Content	The TU LTRAD2665 aims at developing the necessary skills to translate at a high level of competence from Russian into French texts dealing with European matters, relations between the EU or the European space and Russia. It will enable the student to acquire terminological units, to use relevant documentation both in Russian and in French and to develop a thorough comprehension of the underlaying interests at stake in the relations between Europe and Russia.
