Evaluation methods	Regular assessment. End-of-term examination in the working conditions of a professional translator's workstation.				
Teaching methods	In-situ training in specialized translation in the working conditions of a professional translator's workstation. After a personal preparatory study of the text and sharing of ideas and difficulties, the rewrite is completed individually. The teacher helps on demand. The different translation choices of the students will be analysed and compared to those of a published translation.				
Content	Translation of excerpts of contemporary literary works (post Soviet period) in prose and/or translation of catalogues of art collections or exhibitions.
