Among the topics covered are the principles and use of cardiopulmonary bypass, including certain physiological aspects, coronary pathology and the different methods of revascularization, valve pathology, repair techniques and long-term results, heart failure surgery, including ventricular assist devices and transplantation. Finally, the surgical management of congenital heart disease, including a large chapter devoted to the circulatory physiology of the newborn and its pecularities in the context of the use of extracorporeal circulation.
