AND • Summative evaluation based on final individual oral exam at the end of the semester (25 % of final result). <u>For theoretical part: (50 % of final result)</u> Summative written assessment at the end of the semester.</p> <p>August/September Session: The continuous assessment mark will not be taken into account. the written exam (50% of final result). AND the oral exam (50% of final result). The final grade is composed of two integrated parts. Passing both parts is required in order to demonstrate the skills and knowledge defined in the learning outcomes of the course unit. The exam is passed only if each part/ assessment activity has been passed. If the final mark for the course unit is a fail, only the failed part(s) must be retaken.</p>
Teaching methods	<p>Theoretical part: lecture with note-taking, syllabus. Practical part: Listening, reading, understanding, presentation and discussion activities related to cultural and societal subjects.</p>
