Learning outcomes	
Evaluation methods	<p>The evaluation combines (1) the opinion of the tutor (25%) and (2) the 10-page philological research work (75%).</p> <p>In the workplace, the ban on wearing religious symbols stipulated in the work regulations also applies to interns.</p>
Teaching methods	<p>Practical training supported by an internship supervisor and writing of the scientific work under the supervision of the dissertation promoter.</p>
Content	<p>The internship can be carried out in a museum, an archaeological deposit, on an excavation site, etc. Excursions are excluded, but it is possible to participate in the active guidance of a two-week stay in Egypt.</p> <p>In all cases, the course consists of work on textual sources or on a group of objects requiring philological study. This work must also be combined with a contextualized study of the material supports of the inscriptions or the texts studied.</p>
Other infos	<p>The work placement must be carried out in the academic year in which it is included in the student's annual programme.</p>
