Evaluation methods	Written assignment consisting of describing, critiquing, and thoroughly remedying a teaching/learning sequence given by the student during their long internship, incorporating data from research in teaching methodology, theoretical contributions from courses, in particular the history teaching course (LHIST2301 and LHIST2302), the internship support seminar (LHIST9303), and the research methodology course (LEISS2900).
Teaching methods	Alternating between : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • presentations of theoretical and methodological models and tools; • presentations and analyses of research materials produced elsewhere.
Content	Suggesting, testing and building tools with a view to : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Introduce students to literature reviews; • Initiate the construction of a problem and a theoretical framework; • Initiate the construction of a methodological data collection system; • Introduction to research data processing; • Initiating the production of results in relation to the research object and the theoretical framework ; • Initiate discussion of the results.
