Evaluation methods	Production of an annotated thesis plan (theoretical framework, proposed methodological design, avenues for analysis, initial bibliography).
Teaching methods	Alternating between: • Presentations and discussions of theoretical and methodological models and tools; • Presentations, discussions, and analyses of previously produced research materials to inspire and guide students' work.
Content	Equip and support students in order to: • Conduct a literature review • Develop a research question • Develop a theoretical framework • Develop a methodological framework • Collect and process data • Analyze and discuss the results in relation to the research topic and theoretical framework • Demonstrate how the research and results are useful for addressing various educational issues
