Teaching methods	Lectures, with the option of seminars, practical exercises, and guest lectures.
Content	The course aims to provide an overview of the regulations governing the conservation and protection of immovable cultural heritage, including those at the international and national levels. It will enable students to identify the main relevant instruments of international law and to apply the principles and recommendations that apply in these areas, particularly in the regulations of Flanders, Brussels, and the German-speaking Community. The regulations applicable in the Walloon Region are examined in greater depth.
