Main themes	<p>To achieve its objectives, the course consists of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - presenting a historical and doctrinal reinterpretation in Christology and soteriology; - introduce to the current problems in these fields; - initiate the practice of dogmatic theology. <p>This part of the course includes an introduction to the elaboration of a problem and a practical introduction to the bibliographic instruments; it leads the student to write a work which gives him/her the opportunity to put into practice the elements of this initiation and to develop an active relation with the material.</p>
Learning outcomes	<p>At the end of this learning unit, the student is able to :</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1 - identify major Christological issues ; 2 - describe the stages of the development of soteriology ; 3 - indicate the orientations of contemporary Christology and soteriology ; 4 - deal with a particular issue with the help of appropriate bibliographic instruments.
Content	The course analyzes Christology and soteriology from the point of view of the biblical theology, historical theology and systematic theology.
