Main themes	The course will consist of five parts. The first part will focus on the labour market situation in Belgium and Europe, as well as defining fundamental notions and concepts that enable us to understand and analyse decisions and issues relating to employment policies. The second part will present the actors and main objectives/guidelines of employment policies in Europe, Belgium and its regions. The third part will briefly discuss the different models of social protection. The fourth part will address the reforms carried out in Europe since the late 1990s. The fifth part will deal with the effects, evaluation and critical analysis of employment policies.
