## Teaching method

Les étudiants sont invités, dans différents **travaux individuels ou de groupe**, à porter un regard réflexif sur leur pratique professionnelle ou à étudier et résoudre des problèmes de gestion en lien avec leur domaine professionnel.

Ce programme bénéficie d'un corps professoral principalement composé de praticiens expérimentés et privilégie donc une approche pédagogique basée sur les études de cas, les séminaires et les travaux pratiques.
